- 5. Passionate about listening to students.

- 7. Committed to working on a team to minister.
- 8. Must have attended Ouest for a minimum of 6 months
- 9. Must have an interview with Youth Director
- 10. Must complete application
- 11. Must agree to a national background check

Youth Director's Commitments to You:

I commit to invest in leaders through personal one-on-one time, ministry time with students, leaders...

- 1. To help you grow as a lover of Jesus and a servant of humanity. This includes your relationship with Jesus and your relationships with others (family, friends, co-workers, etc.).
- 2. To provide you with enough support and structure that you feel confident in your ability to journey through life with students.
- 3. To be accessible to you.
- 4. To encourage you to share your dreams, ideas, hopes, concerns, and critiques with regards to the student ministry. We are committed to being responsive to your input.

General Expectations:

- 1. Commit to participating in Youth Ministry at Quest until from June 22, 2014 until June 14, 2015.
- 2. Meet with Youth Director for an hour prior to our first gathering to go over child protection policies or go to a Quest sponsored seminar on the subject.
- 3. Attend program to which you committed a minimum of 90% of the time.

Amplify p.m. Leaders' Specific Expectations:

- 1. Amplify p.m. will be on Sunday nights from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Leaders need to arrive by 6:00 p.m. for a brief meeting each week.
- 2. Serve on a team as a small group leader.
- 3. Get to know you're the students' names. Pray for your group members at least 3 times a week by name.
- 4. Attempt to interact with students outside of Amplify p.m. at least once every two months. This can include attending church sponsored events, extracurricular activities, grabbing a meal with your small group after church, emailing, texting, writing notes, etc. Be sure to communicate with parents as well so that you are on the same page.
