

# Mission Partner MATCH UP

C-Groups are invited to participate being matched with one of Quest's Mission Partners in order to learn more about them, provide support, and go deeper in a reciprocal relationship as one part of your spiritual formation. C-Groups are asked to commit to doing the following 3 things with their matched Partner:

- {PRAY}** Once per month – gather requests and pray for your Mission Partner.
- {GIVE}** Once per year - financially support your Partner through a gift (roughly \$200 in Good Neighbor Fund can be used or other funds toward a Christmas gift, project support, etc.)
- {CONNECT}** Fall through June – correspond with your Mission Partner via email and learn about their ministry, connect and care in a relationship, share prayer requests and encouragement, and learn about the ministry, people, and place your Mission Partner serves.
