

Mission Partner Match-Up

Linking C-Groups With Mission Partners

WHAT | Mission Partner Match-Up is a Quest initiative that connects those active in C-Groups (Community Groups) with our church's Global and Local Mission Partners. Each match-up will invite a C-Group to connect to their assigned Mission Partner for one year and engage with them in 3 ways:

- 1) **Pray** for their work every month
- 2) **Give** financial support once per year (i.e. a Christmas gift, donation, etc.)
- 3) **Activate** by attending an event, meeting the partner, or learning about their ministry.

WHY | Our church's mission is to Love God, Love People, and Make Disciples of All People. Our Mission Partners are so valuable to us as a church because they help us live out that mission - our partners are the local experts in their areas of ministry and locations, and are able to help us get to know the people that they are gifted at loving, discipling, and called to serve. We are inviting our C-Groups to be personally transformed by learning more about these Mission Partners and who they serve; often times we are the ones missing out on not seeing the miracles already happening in our midst and the ways God is already at work in mission in both Seattle and globally. The Mission Partner Match-up exists to strengthen the connection and communication between these Mission Partners so that the average Quester gets a better view of the breadth and depth of God at work. And it helps us support and bless our partners through deepening our relationships, growing our awareness, and supporting them financially.

HOW | Review the list of potential partners; if you would like to choose your own Mission Partner to be matched with, you can select one apply using the online form link. (If you do not choose a Mission Partner one will be chosen for you.) Your C-Group then needs to do three things:

1. Determine a **point person in your C-Group** who will maintain an ongoing connection with your Mission Partner and relay information to the rest of the group.
2. **Sign up online** through this form to share/receive contact information on your partner:
